

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


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# A Message From Your Potentate

### **NORFOLK DONATION AND VANS**

It was quite the Christmas gift when representatives of the Farrell Heckman Estate announced in December the Sesostris Shriners would be receiving a substantial donation in recognition of the work the Shriners do helping children with disabilities. Farrell Heckman's legacy has been instrumental with several projects in the Norfolk area.

With the gift of \$250,000, the Sesostris Shrine of Lincoln and Shriner's International will be able to help more children with special needs. The two vans, purchased from Cornhusker Auto, will be used to provide transportation to the Shrine Hospital for children in the Twin Cities. One van will be housed in the Norfolk area while the other will replace a well-used van in Lincoln. Cornhusker Auto is providing storage for the local van.



On March 15, 2018 the official presentation of the vans and the monetary gift was conducted as a part of the NE Nebraska Shrine Club's annual Circus Kickoff Dinner. A large contingent from the Divan and members of the local club were in attendance. Our special guests for the evening were: the administrators of the Farrell Heckman Estate; Mike Mayfield, and his wife, Jennifer; and, Rob Huntley and his wife Roxy. In addition, our guests included the Mayfield's nephew and former Shrine patient, Travis Schaeffer, along with his parents. The stories about our benefactor were very interesting and gave special meaning to the gift the Shrine received.

This was all a great start to our spring activities with a Patient Screening Clinic in Norfolk on April 6, 2018.

#### **CAMP ACHIEVE FUNDRAISER**



# OUTREACH CLINIC APRIL 7, 2018

Nobles and Friends,

Recently, it was announced that changes were being considered for how we care for our kids at Shriners Hospitals for Children-Twin Cities. These changes are in concert with the national trends in healthcare toward more outpatient-oriented care while the need for overnight medical (inpatient) care declines. At present, only a small part of our service involves overnight stays.

Recent news stories together with recent discussions at the winter MSA meeting has created uncertainty, many questions and a slew of rumors both for the nobility and for our Hospital staff.

The SHC-TWI Board of Governors want to make some things very clear, and end some rumors; We ARE NOT CLOSING the Twin Cities Hospital! We are developing plans for a transition to an Ambulatory Surgical Center (day surgery) service model. The vast majority of our work is currently in an outpatient environment and none of that is changing. Our kids will continue to get the greatest care available to them, just as they always have. The only change is for the inpatient procedures that will be shifted to other partnering facilities, just as we are currently doing for selected cases.

Along with this change, we are also planning efforts to expand our presence throughout our service area. This expansion will take on a variety of forms that could include new affiliations with other healthcare organizations and individual providers, expanding the use of our telehealth technologies and establishing physical clinics, just as a few examples. We see this as an exciting opportunity that supports the SHC system initiative of "Reaching More Kids in More Places."

As a Board, we want you to know that we are fully engaged in this change process and are committed to giving our nobility, and our friends, valid information about any changes. We are also committed to ensuring any changes are done in a proper and well planned out format, that not only creates "logical" business sense, but also remembers the human element of all involved, both our wonderful staff, our patients and their families. The SHC-Twin Cities Board of Governors has communicate our expectations regarding planning and timelines for any transition to the Joint Boards to ensure all parties involved have like expectations.

We ask for your continued help and support as these changes unfold. We commit to communicating information to all of the Temples supporting SHC-Twin Cities. On behalf of the SHC-TWI Board of Governors, we thank you and your nobility for your support!

#### **HOSPITAL BOG UPDATE**

Having been recently appointed to the Board of Governors (BOG) for the Twin Cities Hospital (TC), I have been trying to get a grasp and learn my role as a board member. It's a task that I thought I could work into gradually. But, that was not the case.

At my first official meeting in January, we were joined by representatives from Imperial, including Imperial Sir Jerry Gantt and others from Tampa. A presentation was made to the TC-SHC regarding changes to the Twin Cities hospital. Their message focused on "treating more kids in more places." Their vision is to transform TC from an in-patient surgical care hospital to an Ambulatory Surgical Center and to reach out to more kids within the geographical area served by TC. Many outlying locations and possible options were discussed – but no specifics on how it would happen were provided. We were left with an impression that Tampa has a specific plan for how they would like to proceed with making changes. Yet, they were unable to communicate exactly what that plan is.

At the February meeting, the BOG voted unanimously to support the changes to an Ambulatory Surgical Center as the number of in-patient stays do not support the current system of health care that TC provides. With the advances in medicine, many health care providers within the Shrine system and public sector are facing the same challenges as TC. The Executive Committee of the BOG, along with the top administrators at the hospital, are aggressively pursuing opportunities for collaboration with other providers in the Twin Cities. The ultimate goal is to continue providing excellent care for our current patients and to all future patients of Shriners Hospitals for Children - Twin Cities.

Until we have a definite plan in place, I would encourage us all to continue looking for kids that need our help. That is our mission.

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#### **NOTICE ABOUT FOOD HANDLER PERMITS**

Please see the important message below from Officer Manager Keith Plummer about the new policy regarding food handler permits:

One of the continuing chores that I have inherited from Bob is the collection of food handler permits. Everyone who volunteers to help in the kitchen for one of our events needs to get at least a "Serve & Clean Permit." This applies to anyone who carries food from the kitchen or carries plates and dishes back to the kitchen and washes dishes.

If you are involved with the actual cooking of food, you need to get a "Prep Cook Permit." The next level is a "Restricted Shift Manager Permit." Any time food is being prepared, there needs to be at least one of these permit holders on the premises.

The final level is a "Food Protection Manager Permit." Every establishment has to have at least one of these on file with the Health Department. You can get these permits online by going to www.lincoln.ne.gov. Once on that page, select "Forms & Permits." Then, look under "F" for "Food Handler." This will take you to the "Food Safety Section" where you will select "Get your Lincoln Food Handler or Server/Seller permit online."

There is one \$20 fee for the first three levels and an additional fee if you go on for the Food Protection Manager permit. Once you complete a course you will receive a certificate. A copy of this certificate needs to be on file in the Shrine Office. Thank you to everyone who has completed this process and everyone else needs to be aware of this new requirement.






