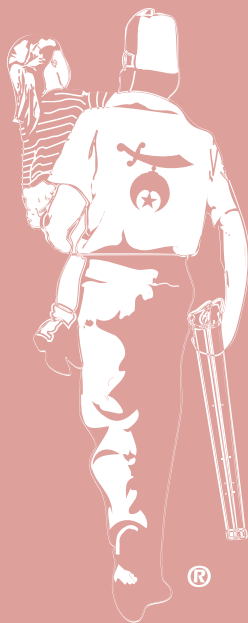

Last month, we were able to do some terrific events, including our Annual Fez Run/Walk at Holmes Lake Park on October 3 (benefitting Shrine hospital patients attending Camp Explore), an FAC on October 8, a Casino Night on October 14, Boo at the Children's Zoo on October 26-30, and our Children's Halloween Party on October 29.

The 16th Annual Sportsman's Raffle on October 23 was a huge success. It was our primary fundraiser for this year and it exceeded everyone's expectations. Thank you to all who sold and bought raffle tickets, the Nobles and ladies who helped in setting up, working the event, and taking it down. A shoutout to Chairman Randy Rutt and his committee on a great job. It was clearly a day that the Shrine shined.

I am so thankful for the generosity shown by our clubs and units at Recognition Night on November 12 and all the awards they earned this year. The clubs and units gave our Shrine over \$50,000 for operating expenses. Over \$40,000 was given to our Transportation Fund to support our Shrine patients, with almost \$30,000 coming from the Tribesmen MC. I was pleased to recognize our 50- and 60-year Nobles, the Northeast Shrine Club as Club of the Year, Iron Nobles as Unit of the Year, Ray Schultz as Rookie of the Year, and Randy Rutt as Shriner of the Year. There were special presentations by Noble Ed Raper on the U.S. flag and Ill. Sir Bill Nelson on the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Lady Bonnie Hoffman was presented an Admiralship in the Great Navy of the State of Nebraska from Governor Pete Ricketts by Noble Roger Wells.

A special thank you to Noble Josh Pitstick for getting a wheelchair accessible van donated by Rick Sheehy at Midwest Medical. The 2018 Ford van has under 60,000 miles and has a rear lift capable of lifting 600 pounds, allowing us to transport Shrine hospital patients in manual and powered wheelchairs.

Thank you to the Divan officers and their ladies for all you have done this past year. Thank you to our office staff including Dan Bolin, who will be retiring at the end of the year, as well as Antonia Tang and Cindy Lehn for all you do. Please welcome David Weidner, who will be taking over as the new office manager after the first of the year.

Thank you to my chief aides, Noble Paul Campbell and Lady Barb, and their teams. Thank you to my personal aides, Ill. Sir Bob Nemecek and Lady Ronell, Noble Ed Reinhardt and Lady Cecelia; and our Chief Decorator, Nancy Weers and her team. Finally, thank you to FEZtivities Editor, Laura Strimple Borske, and Ill. Sir Drew Borske for all of their work in putting together this FEZtivities magazine.

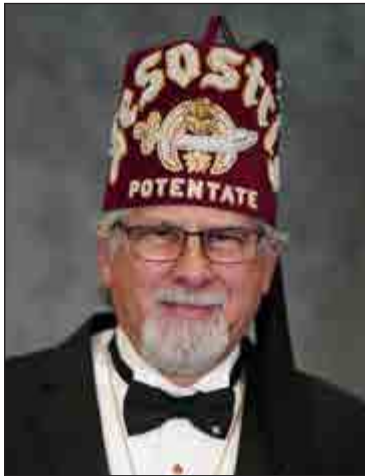

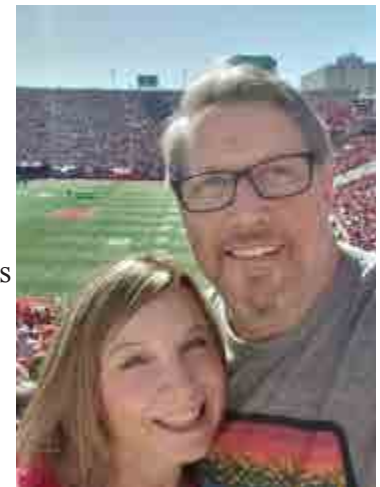
NEW OFFICE MANAGER

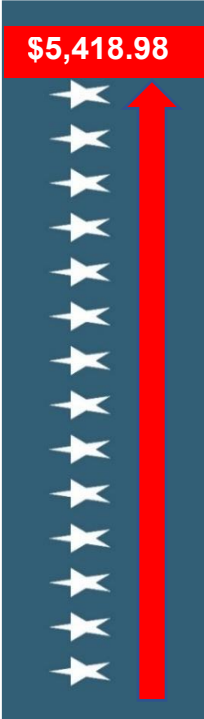

About Our Float

Children often have big dreams for their future – dreams of what they want to become, and what they would like to accomplish. Often, children with medical issues or disabling conditions may be encouraged to scale back those dreams, or even abandon them entirely, and settle for something much smaller. However, at Shriners Children’s we believe in dreams and limitless possibilities. We take the time to truly listen to our patients and families, and acknowledge their goals and dreams as we create their personal plan for care and treatment.

Our Rose Parade float, Celebrating 100 Years of Believing in Dreams, will honor this philosophy and the difference it has made in the lives of the more than 1.5 million children since our first hospital opened in 1922. Watch the parade on New Year’s Day to see our celebration of Shriners Hospitals for Children depicted in the beautiful language of flowers. Our National Patient Ambassadors Sydney, Seth, Connor and Mia will join our mascot, Fezzy, and other honored guests on our float at the traditional parade in Pasadena, California.

How/Why Our Theme Was Chosen

Our entry, Celebrating 100 Years of Believing in Dreams, honors Shriners Children’s century of providing quality care to children with complex medical conditions, regardless of the ability to pay or insurance status. Equally, the theme recognizes the power of hopes and dreams, and celebrates our patients’ resilience and determination as they discover how much is possible, begin to believe in their dreams and gain the confidence to achieve their goals. Helping our patients discover how much they can accomplish has been a hallmark of the philosophy of Shriners Children’s throughout its history. We look forward to a second century of transforming the lives of children.

How Our Float’s Theme Relates To The Parade Theme

The 2022 Tournament of Roses Parade’s theme of Dream. Believe. Achieve. can be seen throughout our float. Aspects of our theme, Celebrating 100 Years of Believing in Dreams, emphasize the parade theme. 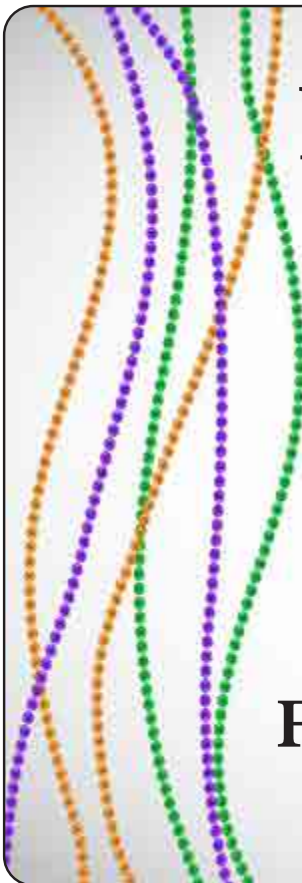

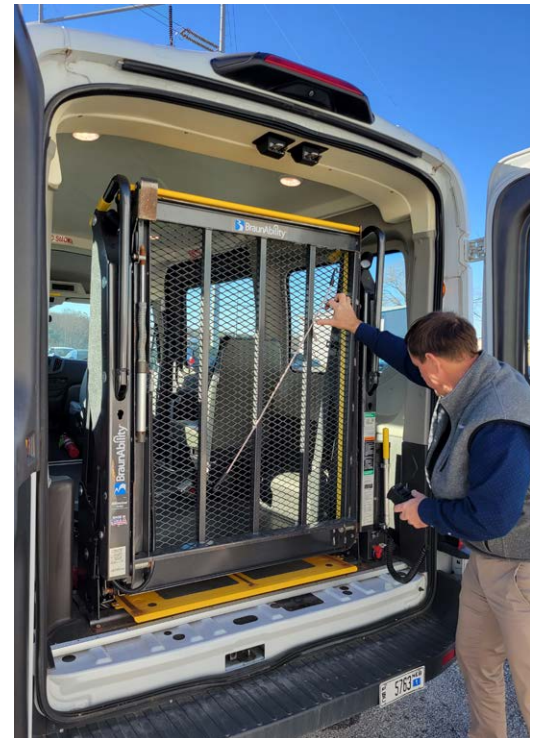

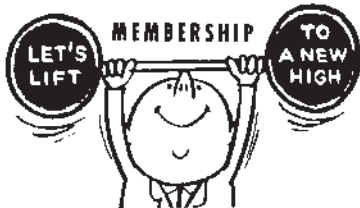

Effective January 1, 2022

1. Each line signer, in good standing, will receive one point for a new petition, a restoration or an affiliation.
2. After a Noble attains five points, he will receive a membership medallion with a red, green and yellow ribbon. For each succeeding five petitions, he will receive a diamond in his membership medallion for a maximum of five diamonds.
