

## **MEET PETE KRUSE**


#### **Outer Guard**

For each succeeding five petitions, he will receive a diamond in his membership medallion for a maximum of five diamonds. Once he has been a line signer for 35 petitions, he will receive a gold ribbon to wear with his membership medallion.
- 3. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for TWO Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to receive a "membership achiever" polo shirt.
- 4. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for FIVE Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to have his Sesostris Shrine dues paid for the next calendar year.
- 5. Line signers, if they desire, may place the Fez on their new Noble during the fezzing ceremony.
