
Climb aboard the Sesostris train as we journey through 2023 together. We are looking forward to a great trip!

A Message from the First Lady-Elect


Thank you for the opportunity to serve Sesostris Shrine this year as First Lady. It is truly an honor to follow in the footsteps of our past First Ladies.





Imperial Sir John D. VerMaas

John D. – Everybody from Sesostris Shriners to Imperial officers going back many years knows him as John D. He is, in a word, an institution around Shrinedom. He became a Master Mason in 1959 and a Sesostris Shriner in 1962. John F. Kennedy was President. John D. was presented his 60-year Shrine pin November 11, 2022. John D. was Mr. Everything in the Sesostris Harleys unit. He was appointed Sesostris Outer Guard in 1974 and progressed up the line to being elected our temple Potentate in 1984. Today, only one living past Potentate has served Sesostris longer. After serving as Potentate, John

D. did not call it a day. He remained active in all things Sesostris and in 1985 ran unsuccessfully for Imperial Outer Guard. Not at all discouraged, as candidates many times need at least two attempts before being elected to the Imperial line, John D. again tossed his fez in the Imperial Outer Guard ring and was elected. From 1985 thru 1995 John D. progressed up the Imperial elected line and on July 6, 1995 became only the second person from Sesostris to be installed Imperial Potentate. That's right. Since Sesostris' charter in 1888, only two from Sesostris have risen to be the Number One Shriner in the entire world, Imperial Potentate.

John D. wanted Harley Davidson to build a Shriner special edition Harley while he was Imperial Potentate. Harley Davidson agreed IF John D. could secure 100 orders. He did, plus 1100 more! Imperial Sir John D. was installed in New Orleans, LA and, against all warnings, drove his Harley down the center aisle of the Convention Center to the stage to be installed. How he managed to start the Harley with no gasoline in the tank, as required by the local Fire Marshall, remains a mystery to this day! As Imperial Potentate John D travelled the world and continued to work tirelessly directing hospital upgrades and construction system-wide. First Lady Jan originated the Imperial First Lady's Fundraising program which is still active today, generating hundreds of thousands of dollars to help Shrine kids.

John D's Imperial parade as outgoing Imperial Potentate was in St. Louis. First Temple in the parade was Sesostris but that particular parade began with John D. on his Harley alongside country singer/TV star Roy Clark, a fellow Shriner courtesy of John D. on his Harley and nearly 1000 other Shriners riding Harleys. The sight and sound of those Harleys is something I will never forget!

As a Harley post-script, John D. wanted Harley Davidson to build a Shriner special edition Harley while he was Imperial Potentate. Harley Davidson agreed *IF* John D. could secure 100 orders. He did, plus 1100 more!



Following John D's 11 years on the Imperial line, he served as Chairman of SHC board of directors and its president for three years. He continued to travel the world for Shrinedom during that time and directed construction, modernization, and expansion of SHC.

For those of you active during John D's years serving us, you know how much John D. was admired, respected and loved by all. The impression John D. left on Shriners everywhere cannot be fully understood or appreciated unless you were there. An institution, unquestionably. I became a Shriner in 1988 and had the distinct pleasure to see John D. work his magic. I am who I am in large part because of John D. and will always have the utmost respect for him and what he accomplished as the world's Number One Shriner.

While John is no longer capable of joining his fellow Shriners in Arizona for these cold Nebraska winters, he visits Sesostris on occasion and continues to enjoy a comfortable retirement here in Lincoln where he resides with his wife Jeanne in the Bishop Square Townhome on S. 27th Street. His favorite buddy "Tucker" keeps a watchful eye on both of them, and freely offers up endless warm companionship. We at Sesostris are blessed to know and to have shared many of life's Shrine experiences with John D. Tell him "Thanks!" when you see him.

MEMBERSHIP INCENTIVES PROGRAM REVISED

Effective January 1, 2023

- 1. Each line signer, in good standing, will receive one point for a new petition. a restoration or an affiliation.
- 2. After a Noble attains five points, he will receive a membership medallion with a red, green and yellow ribbon. For each succeeding five petitions, he will receive a diamond in his membership medallion for a maximum of five diamonds. Once he has been a line signer for 35 petitions, he will receive a gold ribbon to wear with his membership medallion.
- 3. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for TWO Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to receive a 2023 parade shirt (various colors available) with embroidered emblem and name of Shriner.
- 4. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for FIVE Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to have his Sesostris Shrine dues paid for the next calendar year.
- 5. Line signers, if they desire, may place the Fez on their new Noble during the fezzing ceremony.
