





This program is **not** to replace the Tree Sponsors, without whom we wouldn't have an event. Plaque sponsors will simply be able to support the event without the same level of commitment.



Meet Gavin

There was a time when Gavin's family wasn't sure he'd reach his first birthday, let alone crawl or walk.

In 2009, at 6 months old, Gavin became critically ill with meningococcal meningitis, a bacterial infection that can cause rashes and lesions, resulting in amputations. Living in rural South Dakota, Gavin was first transferred to a hospital in Kansas, where his mom, Echo, began to understand the severity of the infection. "He was in a coma and the doctors said he had about a 5% chance of survival," Echo recalled. "They also wanted to start amputations." Echo asked if there were any hospitals that specialized in treating conditions like Gavin's. There was: Shriners Children's Ohio.

Gavin spent the next 54 days at Shriners Children's. He endured 12 surgeries, including a tracheotomy, skin grafts and muscle flaps to preserve as much healthy tissue as possible. He was also kept on infection control precautions, which meant everyone, including his mom, had to wear medical gowns, gloves and masks.

The clinical team not only closely monitored his recovery progress, but also his developmental milestones. During his nearly two-month stay in the hospital, Gavin first rolled over, sat up unassisted, ate semi-solid foods and started babbling.

After he was discharged, Gavin and his mom traveled from South Dakota to Ohio nearly 60 times so the clinical team could monitor his skin grafts, flexibility and strength. He also became a patient at Shriners Children's Twin Cities to keep an eye on an issue with the growth plate in his right knee and ankle. It remained unchanged, so when he was 10, Gavin decided the next step forward in his recovery would be amputation.

Gavin admits that people stare at his prosthetic leg and the scarring over most of his body, but he's used to being in the spotlight. "I was a lead in my school play for three years in a row," he said. "I stood in front of a lot of people with the governor of South Dakota to light the capital Christmas tree. I've spoken to hundreds of people in South Dakota, North Dakota and Ohio about my story and how Shriners Children's saved my life."

In fact, Gavin is so comfortable with meeting new people and trying new experiences, he has earned the nickname "Governor Gav." But his favorite title is the one he earned when he was just 6 months old. "I'm a Shriners kid," he declared. "From day one, Shriners have felt like family to me. There is a life-long bond to the organization and everyone who give kids like me hope for an optimistic future."

Shriners Children Twin Cities continues to collaborate with Chicago, St. Louis and Dayton, sharing resources and talent. Our doctors are visiting these locations to learn and grow and to share their talents with other doctors in the Shrine system. They are also doing surgeries at these locations as we explore other Shriners Hospital for us to refer our kids to.

Dr. Lang, our local sports medicine physician is busy growing the discipline in the Twin Cities and has been traveling to St. Louis to help there as well. Dr. Lang has represented the Twin Cities at numerous conventions, bringing our story to the medical world. Even after 100 years many in the medical field don't know what we do.

For many years, Shriners Hospitals for Children in addition to providing the most amazing care anywhere, also invested time, energy and resources into research. The Twin Cities currently is participating in the Genomics Study project with Imperial. DNA samples are taken from patients and family volunteers to be studied and analyzed to determine if there are genetic conditions that might lead to the medical challenges that our patients face. The Twin Cities have reached out to Boy Town to see if collaboration with their Cerebral Palsy gait lab is possible. When it comes to genomic/DNA research, Shriners is just getting started.

On Thursday, October 16, 2025, Melissa Bongard, the Clinic Director at Shriners Children Twin Cities, other staff members and hopefully an Imperial Officer will present a town hall meeting at Sesostris. Melissa will share with us all the exciting things that are happening at the clinic now and what's coming.

This dinner event is open to all Shriners and their ladies, and members of Naphis Temple, Daughters of the Nile (and anyone else who would like to know what's happening). Social will begin at 5:30pm, dinner at 6pm and the program will start at 6:30pm. The cost for dinner prepared by the Gourmet Club has yet to be determined.

Save the date, we hope you can attend.







MEMBERSHIP INCENTIVES PROGRAM

Effective January 1, 2025

- 1. Each line signer, in good standing, will receive one point for a new petition, a restoration or an affiliation.
- 2. After a Noble attains five points he will receive a membership medallion with ribbon.
- 3. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who serves as a top line signer for TWO Nobles within a single calendar year will be eligible to receive a Port Authority button-down shirt featuring an embroidered emblem with "Sesostris" and "Top Line Signer."
- 4. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for FIVE Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to have his Sesostris Shrine dues paid for the next calendar year.
- 5. Line signers, if they desire, may place the Fez on their new Noble during the fezzing ceremony.
